Geoscience Professor Emeritus Dr. James Carter UTD held a Bachelor's of Science degree in mining & geological engineering and a PhD in Geochemistry from Rice University. World renowned for his simulated moon dust he made for NASA, and the findings of a dinosaur in Big Bend National Park. James was preceded in death by his wife Phyllis J.
