Mary Louise Parker, age 92, of Lewisville, Texas was welcomed into the Kingdom of Heaven on January 30, 2018, surrounded by her Immediate family. Mary was born on November 8, 1925 in Floyd, Texas to Oscar and Bess Landrum. She was one of 8 children and grew up living on a farm.
