Rowland “Ron” S Giller II, 77, of Dallas, Texas passed away Monday, April 3, 2017. He was born on March 2, 1940 in Columbus, Ohio and was preceded in death by his wife, Yvonne Rose (Philpot) Giller, daughter, Mary Clara Giller; brother, Michael Giller and parents, Rowland Stanley Giller and Mary Elizabeth (Cotter) Giller. Ron is survived by his loving daughter Alyson Giller (New York City) and grand-puppy Lulu. Ron had a gift for gab and was an accomplished salesman who found his love for printing at Heritage Press.
