Harrison, Cornelius Harrison, sisters Bertha Jones and Ada Cherry preceded her in death. Marguerite grew up in Lake Como, Fort Worth, Texas. She was educated in the Fort Worth ISD. She was married to Roland Coit Sr. and with that union, three children were born. During her life time, she was a mother, caregiver, and an excellent cook. Also, she was involved in the community, where she was a poll worker. She also served as a PTA President of Hamilton Park School. Marguerite was a member of Bethel AME Church, St. Paul White Rock AME Church, where she served as a Stewardess.
