LM Crocker was born December 20, 1926 in Grand Saline, Texas, and passed away September 24, 2016 in Winnsboro, Texas. LM was born in and attended school in Grand Saline, TX. He entered the Navy in 1944. He trained in Great Lakes, IL, Davisville, RI and Camp Parks, CA. He served in the Pacific and Okinawa during WWII. He married Annie Lucille Wilson on May 19, 1947 and welcomed three children, six grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren. He joined the Dallas Fire Department in March of 1949. He spent 28 years serving his community as a Firefighter and Captain; he retired in March of 1977. He was a Master Mason and Shriner of the 32nd degree as part of the Grand Lodge of Texas. LM was a devout Christian. He was an active member of Pleasant Mound United Methodist Church in Dallas for over 30 years. In retirement, LM and Annie were avid travelers who toured most of the country in their RV, taking their grandchildren on many adventures. LM dabbled in real estate, enjoyed round dancing, and loved his family.
