Robert Jackson Bice (“Bob”) was born in Dallas Texas on September 15, 1933. Bob graduated from Highland Park High School in 1951 and then from the University of Texas in 1955 with a degree in Petroleum Engineering. From there, Bob went into Officer Candidate Training for the U.S. Coast Guard where he later served in Panama City, Florida and New Orleans, Louisiana. On October 23, 1955 Bob and Shirley were married in Three Rivers, Texas. Bob is survived by his wife, Shirley Gayle Brown of Dallas, Texas. He is also survived by his son, Sheldon and his wife Diane and daughter McKenzie of Colorado Springs, Colorado and his daughter Suzanne Smart and her husband David and their sons Jackson and Coleton of Frisco, Texas.
