Janice Louise Wood Farrell Hilz, age 74, of Dallas TX passed away at home on March 9, 2015 surrounded by her family. She was born to Mary Louise and Charles Wood on August 14, 1940, in Dallas. She graduated from North Dallas High School in 1958 and attended the University of Texas. In 1960 she married New Yorker, William “Bill” Farrell and together in Dallas they had four daughters, all in Dallas prior to his early death in 1973. She later met and married George W. Hilz of Pilot Point, TX, and they were married for over 30 years. For many years she worked for the law firm of Bickel & Brewer in their Accounting Department where she made many lasting friendships.
