## **Richard Chilton James**

**R**ichard Chilton James (Dick) passed away on Wednesday, November 12th, 2014. He was born in Houston, Texas, on January 7, 1944. He married his high school sweetheart, Jane Mullins James, on November 15, 1963. Richard served two years in the army (1966-68) and was stationed in Okinawa. They moved to Dallas, TX in 1971 for Richard to attend North Texas State University. He was a life-long member of the Nazarene Church where he served on Church Boards as well as numerous other lay positions. He retired from Broadview Security in 2010. Richard lived a life filled with love, family, laughter, and a strong belief in God. He was happiest when he was surrounded by family and friends.
