Bob Diggs was born on July 1, 1918 in Chicago, Illinois and raised in Duncan, Oklahoma. He graduated from Oklahoma State University as a mechanical engineer and among his many achievements and honor's, he was elected Big Man on campus. Bob served in the Persian Gulf Command during World War II, as a major in the army from 1942-1946. Shorty afterwards, he began working for Halliburton where he remained for 42 years, retiring as Vice President in charge of sales and marketing. Dallas has been his home for the last 10 months.
