## **Emma Jane Vaughn Ivey**

OCT 17, 1923 - SEP 5, 2014

**E**mma Jane passed away Sept. 5, 2014 and was the only child of the late Walter Murrah and Zuleka Roan Vaughn, born October 17, 1923 in Waco, Texas, after which the family moved to Dallas where she lived the rest of her life graduating from Woodrow Wilson High School and attending Hockaday Jr. College and Southern Methodist University where she was a member of Kappa Alpha Theta Sorority. After working as head bookkeeper at Lakewood Bank, she married Robert W. Ivey in December 1945. Emma Jane was active in The Dallas Woman's Club serving on the Board of Governors, and served as President of the Marianne Scruggs Garden Club. She was a member of Christ the King Catholic Church and Altar Society.
