BOOZIOTIS, JEAN HOLLOWEL born December 9, 1932 to the late Luther and Maggie Hollowell, passed away unexpectedly and quickly from natural causes on February 12, 2013 in Dallas, TX. She was born in Albany, TX, raised in Quanah, TX, went to Stevens College in Missouri, then to SMU where she received a degree in journalism.
