## **Sarah Elizabeth Reid**

**R**EID, SARAH , a resident of Dallas since 1935, passed away on January 12, 2013 at the age of 95. She was born to Clemmie L. and Claud Snow Morgan on October 6, 1917, and grew up in Pecan Gap, Texas. There she graduated from High School in 1934, and attended college at East Texas State Teachers College, later earning her degree at Dallas Business College. She married James “Jim” Yeager Reid, also from Pecan Gap, in June 1935; that same year they moved to Dallas. She was preceded in death by Jim, her beloved husband for over 60 years; their son, Jake. She is survived by her daughters-in-law Judy Reid and Nancy Dickinson; grandchildren, Rusty and wife Molly Reid of Fort Worth and Brian and wife Denise Reid of Mesquite; six great-grandchildren, Heather, Sainty, Jake, Trevor, Charlie and Emma Reid.
