He served for 4 years in the U.S. Navy during World War II and was a graduate of East Texas State. He received his Masters degree from SMU. Hill was a math teacher at Adamson High School in Dallas ISD for 7 years and was the Executive Director for the Dallas Building Owners and Managers for 32 years. He was Active with the City of Dallas, serving on their boards and commissions including: Dallas Fire Council, Economic and Development council and others.
