CLOWER, LILLIAN VICKERS (“MawMaw”) 90, passed away May 29, 2011, in Sherman, Texas. Lillian was born, July 18, 1920, in Buckner, Arkansas. She married Argus Eugene Clower, Jr. in September of 1937. Their first son, Richard was born in December of ’38 and their other son, Ronald was born in October of ’40. They lived in Arkansas briefly and moved to Texarkana when the boys were school-aged. “Lil” and “AE” raised their boys for most of their school years in Texarkana and then eventually moved to Garland, Texas, where their youngest, Ron finished school.
