Efflandt, Virginia Simpson, 85, passed away March 12, 2011 from Alzheimer's. She was born to C. B. and Ethel Simpson on May 14, 1925. Predeceased by her mother and father; sister, Charlotte Sather and husband Herbert Efflandt. Virginia graduated from W. H. Adamson HS June 4, 1943. She went to work for SW Bell in July 1943 and retired in February 1983 after 39 years as accounting manager. On June 26, 1948 she married Herbert R. Efflandt.
