Janie H. Campbell, age 62, of Dallas, Texas passed away peacefully on February 17, 2011 at her home after a three-year fight with brain cancer. She was born on March 2, 1948 in Sulphur Springs, Texas to her parents, J.C. and Audrey Hollingsworth. Janie was the younger of two children.
