E DISON, JAMES ELMER, 86, passed away January 14, 2010, in Richardson, Texas. He was born February 1, 1924 in Lafayette, Colorado to parents Elmer and Mable Edison. James graduated from Cornell University Tau Beta Pi with a degree in Chemical Engineering. He was part of the V-12 program and served as a Lt. (j.g.) in the U.S. Navy during W. W. II. After the war, James worked for Sun Oil Co. for 40 years. He was a former president of the Lion's Club and of the American Petroleum Institute. He loved singing and playing golf.
