**M**arguerite Evelyn Teafatiller Lang passed away peacefully at home Monday, December 14th, 1925 in Kemp, TX. Her family moved to Dallas when she was seven years old. She graduated from Forest Avenue High School with the class of 1942. It was there that she met and fell in love with her husband of 67 years, Glenn Lang, Jr. They were married December 24th, 1943 and settled in Dallas where they lived ever since and raised two children. Marguerite was the administrative assistant for twenty-two years to Avery Mason, Bishop of the Episcopal Diocese of Dallas, after his passing was administrative assistant to Bishop A. Donald Davies.
