Foster, Lesley Smith Age 56. March 12, 1953 – June 6, 2009. Lesley Smith Foster sadly lost her life on June 6 due to complications following surgery. Her death is a devastating blow to her family and friends. She was born in New Orleans and attended the University of New Orleans where she earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in English. She lived in Metairie, La. until moving to Dallas, Texas following hurricane Katrina. Foster was a federal employee for over 20 years, earning numerous awards as a compliance officer. Her capabilities made a lasting impression on those with whom she worked. She cared deeply for others and was a true good Samaritan. Foster is preceded in death by her father, Bernhard Theodore (Ted) Smith.
