Born November 18, 1968 in Mexia, TX and passed away February 23, 2009 in Dallas, TX. Charlie received his Bachelor of Science from Southern Methodist University. He then received his DDS from Baylor College of Dentistry in Dallas. He was honored and elected as a Diplomate by the International Congress of Oral Implantologists. Charlie was a 6th generation dentist. He is survived by his wife, Sherilyn Williams; 2 daughters, Claudia (5) and Olivia (2) Williams; parents, Charles and Mary Williams; sisters, Rachel Dawn Williams Hoover, Emma Virginia Eileen Williams and Natalie Nicole Williams and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins and other loving family members. 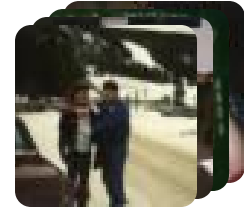

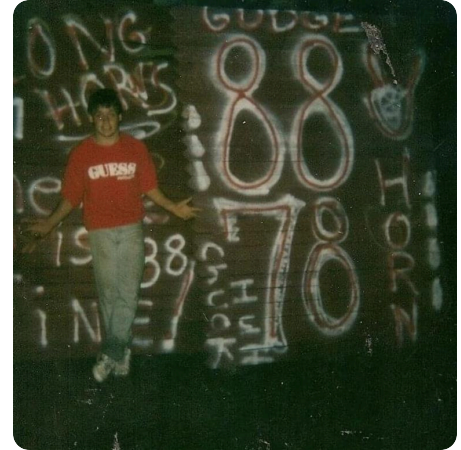

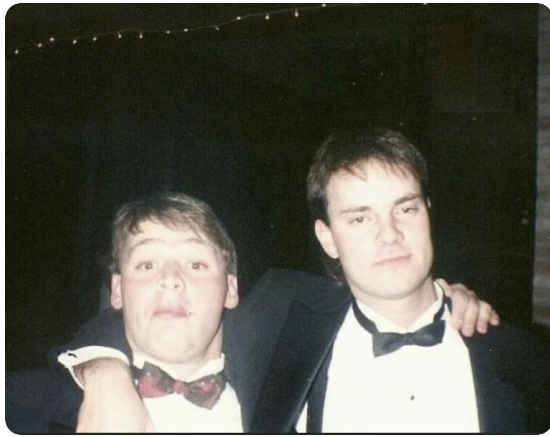
