She was born on October 11, 1936 in Austin, Texas to Charles and Dixie Hines and soon thereafter became a resident of Dallas, Texas. She graduated from Woodrow Wilson High School and subsequently received her bachelor's degree from Southern Methodist University where she belonged to Kappa Alpha Theta Sorority. She majored in elementary education and worked as a first grade school teacher at David Crockett Elementary School in Dallas. After marriage, she and her husband lived two years in Germany during his military service where she again taught first grade in the Army dependent schools. After raising her three sons, she returned to the University of Texas at Arlington receiving her master's degree in social work. Thereafter she spent fourteen years at Parkland Memorial Hospital in the department of social work and continued working throughout much of her illness. She was President of Herron House for a number of years serving people with emotional problems who are returning to the community. She belonged to the Dallas Women's Club, Dallas Garden Club, Dallas County Medical Society Auxiliary and many other organizations.
