If family and friends wish to send flowers, her favorite type were yellow roses. The family suggests that memorial donations be made to the Epilepsy Foundation.

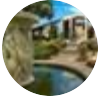

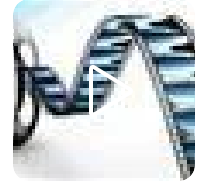
