Roy was born in Bugtussle, Texas Born: November 29, 1935 and passed away October 20, 2020. Roy married Nelda Turman on July 1, 1955. Roy held many titles and roles during his career working early in life as a Dallas Reserve Police officer and was active with civic groups including the Rotary Club and the Dallas Chamber of Commerce. Roy also served as a Deacon at Military Parkway Church of Christ and also served as President of the Lone Star Gas Credit union. Roy retired from Lone Star Gas after 43 years of service as Vice President of the Lone Star Gas Dallas region.

Preceded in death by parents Roy D. and Mildred Roberts and brother Ronnie Roberts.
