He was preceded in death by spouse Gurtdean McKinney and son Isaac Wayne McKinney



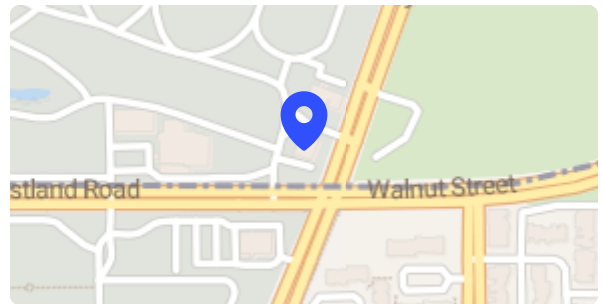

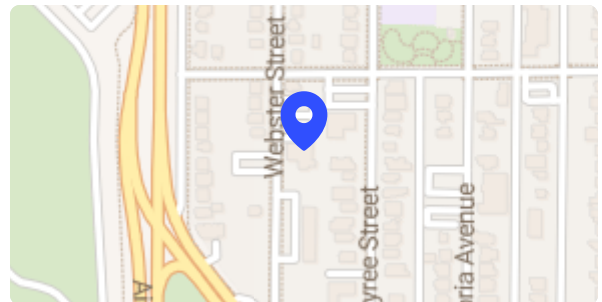

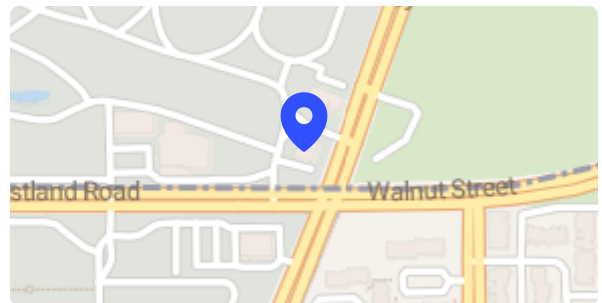
