Burial will be in Salado, Texas where we have many treasured Memories



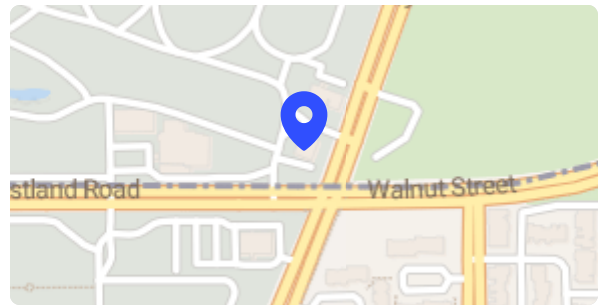
