Born August 7, 1959 in Oak Cliff, Texas.

Died October 30, 2021 in Richardson, Texas at age 62.

Vikki resided in Wylie, Texas.

Born to Ann and Cecil Thomas, Vikki moved to Sunnyvale as an early teen.

She attended North Mesquite High School. In 1977, after seeing Saturday Night Fever Vikki knew she

wanted to dance. She joined Arthur Murry dance school and soon became a ballroom dance instructor.

Vikki entered and won many competitions. She carried her love of dance the rest of her life, even teaching a class at church and giving private lessons to future brides and grooms.

On June 24, 1994 Vikki met Billy on a baseball field. They got engaged in October 1995 and married on

September 21, 1996. Tyler came along a year and a half later and Sammy 5 years after that. Until they

came along the only thing she knew about baseball was it was a place to go and sweat. It wasn't long till

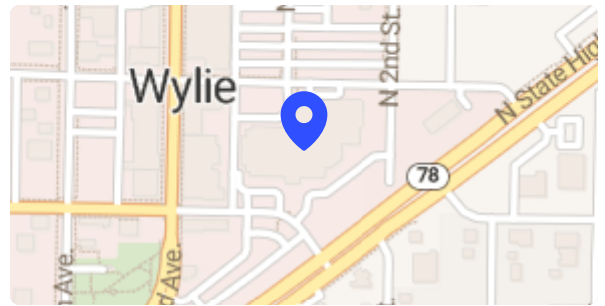
