Christopher Dwayne Gibson was born to Rudolph P. and Idella W. Gibson on February 9th, 1967 in Hammond, Louisiana

Chris proudly attended Southeastern Lab school from Kindergarten to 8th grade and developed lifelong friendships. He was an excellent football and baseball player breaking several records cementing his foundation of his love for sports. Chris hit many home runs at Zemurray Park in Hammond, Louisiana. He grew in his faith and was a member of Greenfield Baptist Church where he was baptized by the late Rev. Nolan Clayton. He played football at Hammond High School as defensive tackle and won a scholarship to attend The Grambling State University, following his mother's alma mater. Chris met his wife in college and moved to Dallas, Texas to pursue a career in serving his community as a Dallas Police Officer.

Chris was a community treasure and worked for the Dallas Police Department for 25 years. He was the definition of a protector and displayed this into the community, schools, and family. 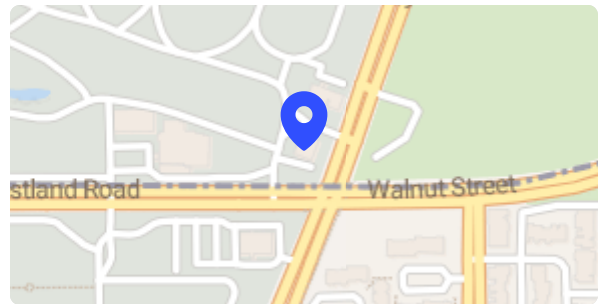

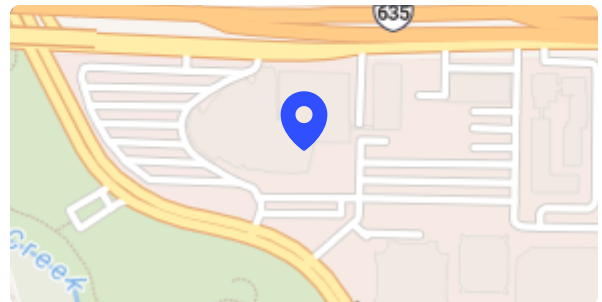

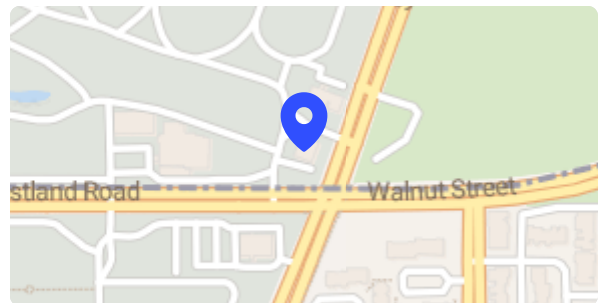
