**I**t is with deep sorrow that I announce the death of my loving husband of 57 years, Ronald (Ron) George Beck-Age 86, of Mesquite, Texas. God called him home Monday, January 17, 2022. He was the son of the late Lillian and Thomas Beck. He was born June 9, 1935 in Bridgewater, Nova Scotia, Canada. 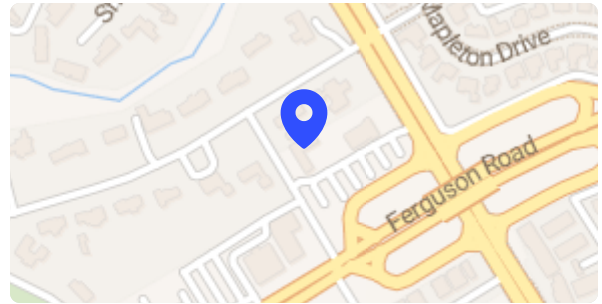

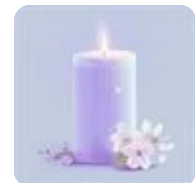
