Internment Restland Memorial Park. Family to receive friends for visitation from 6-8 PM Thursday, April 28, at Restland Funeral Home.

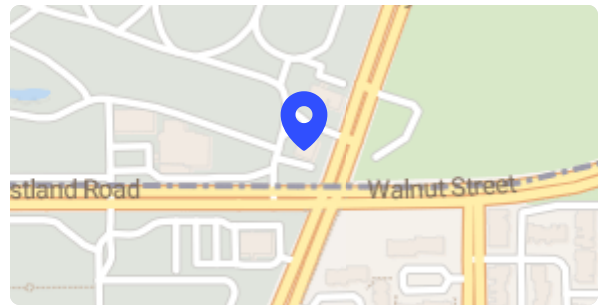

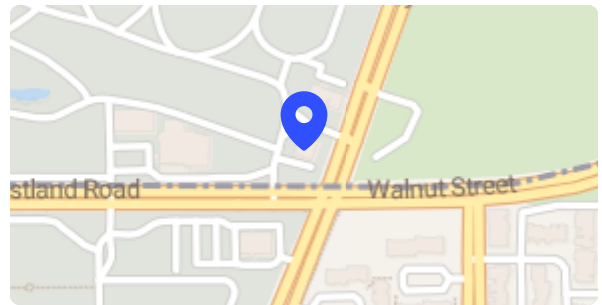
