He was born in Dallas, Texas on April 24, 1962 and passed away in a tragic accident on Thursday, June 2, 2022 in Carrollton, Texas. John was a lifelong resident of Dallas and attended SS Conner Elementary School, Gaston Junior High School, and graduated from Skyline High School in 1981.

John's love of cars started at a very early age. His supercharged Chevy Silverado was a great source of pride for him. He spent countless hours at racetracks such as the Devil's Bowl Speedway with his dad when he was young, and later in life with friends at other tracks around the metroplex. In his younger years he was a very successful remote control car racer. He spent his entire career in the automotive collision field, most recently working at Huffines Chevrolet in Plano where he leaves behind many friends. 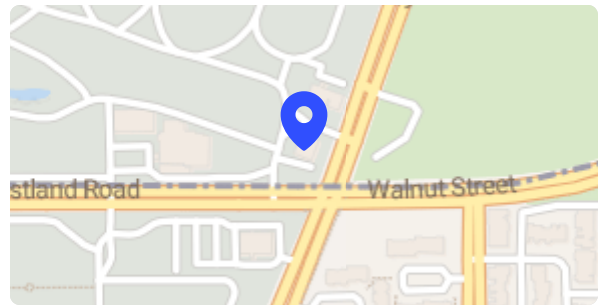

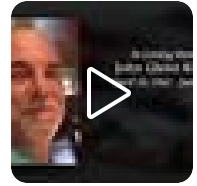

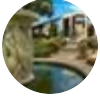
