Long is preceded in death by both his parents: Thuong Thi Lai and Nguyen Van Huynh.

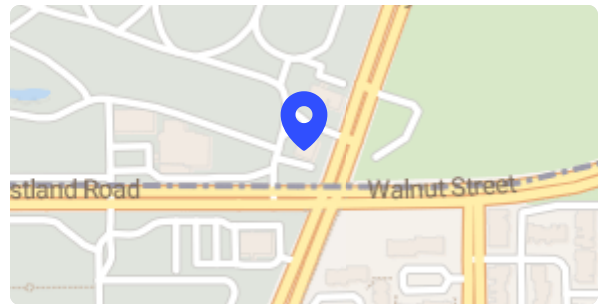

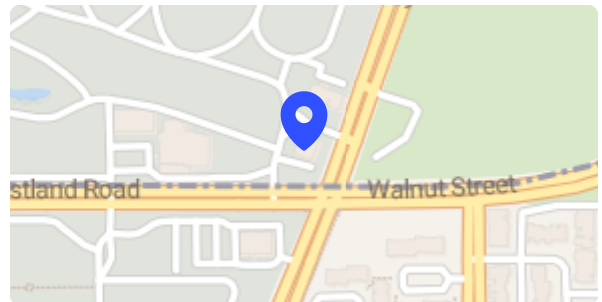

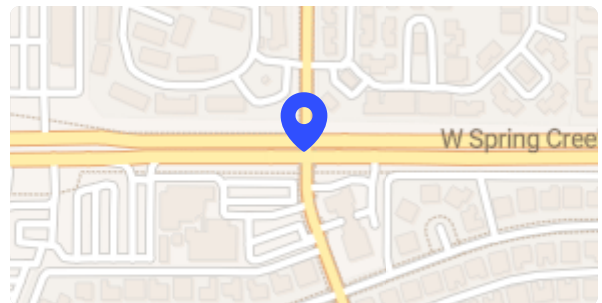
