Born in Gilmer, TX on May 19th, 1951 to Gidget and Paul Erwin Chamberlain. Joe and Kay formed a strong friendship when they met at Casa Linda Theater as teenagers. His service to the Marine Corp. ended in 1970 with his return from Vietnam. Joe and Kay got married in Rockwall in 1976, shortly before moving to Lubbock, TX with their son Chad. After Receiving his Diploma from Texas Tech, he started an Electronics business. The years spent in Lubbock was dedicated to hard work and family. The persistence that he had payed off when he was able to take his family sailing for 2 years with the sale of his business in 1992.
