Helen Hanks Stephens Storey, 96, passed away on Saturday, January 20, 2024 in Dallas, TX. She was the daughter of Harry Stephens and Johnnie Stephens Schatz of Helena, AR, and the beloved wife of Charles Porter Storey of Dallas, TX.

Helen was born in Helena, AR on Christmas Eve at Estevan Hall, a home that had been built and owned by her family for 8 generations. She attended Randolph Macon College, the University of Mississippi, and Southern Methodist University. She married Charles Porter Storey in 1950, a marriage that lasted 58 happy years.

Helen was a traveler extraordinaire and loved entertaining friends! She was deeply committed to the Junior League of Dallas, where she served as a Provisional Chair and Board member for 6 years; the Visiting Nurse Association where she served for 16 years; KERA Radio and TV; and she helped create the Docent Program at the Dallas Museum of Art in which she served for 20 years. Helen helped start Les Femmes du Monde benefiting the Council on World Affairs; was a member of the Dallas Garden Club, the Founders Garden Club of America, and the Dallas Women's Club.

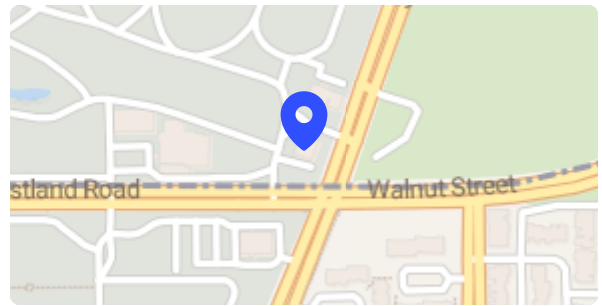

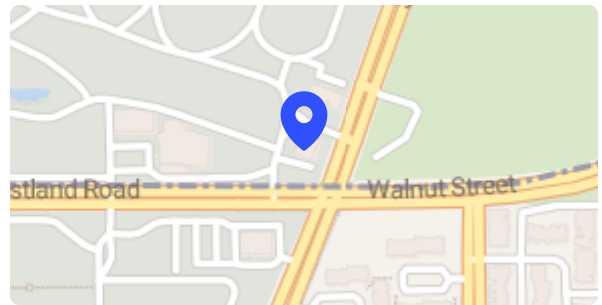
