Amy Schaefer Horby passed away peacefully in her sleep on Saturday February 10th, 2024, in Dallas TX. She was 97. Amy was born October 3, 1926, in Connellsville, PA and was raised in Uniontown, PA. She was the second of four daughters born to Walter Herschel Schaefer and Carrie Blanche Fritz Schaefer. After graduating from Uniontown high school in 1944 Amy began her career with Bell telephone as a switchboard operator. In 1948 she married Michael Horby, a U.S. Marine. In 1953 they moved to Dallas where she pursued various secretarial positions including 25 years of service with the VA hospital. Whether square dancing, creating handmade quilts, bowling, reading, travelling, or pursuing many other activities, Amy found time to provide a hot meal including dessert for her family. Always busy in body, mind and spirit, Amy was an active member of First Presbyterian Church for 70 years, a 50-year member of Beta Sigma Phi sorority and a member of the Elks ladies Dallas lodge participating in the “71 steppers line dance group”. Amy and Michael attended the Ennis polka festival every May and were members of “Branches and Twigs square dance club in Farmers Branch. 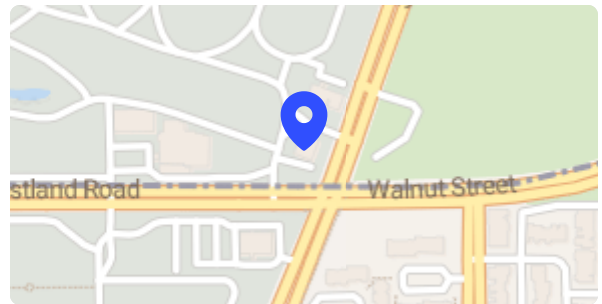

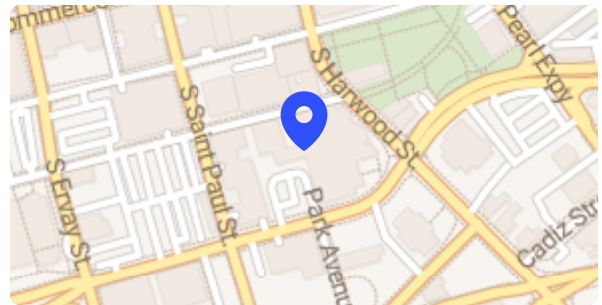
