She often spoke of Hamilton Park's enduring influence, saying it taught her what excellence looks like and that we are called to live by God's principles. In every role, she brought not just knowledge—but wisdom. Her ministry was equally powerful. God saw her fight the good fight and gave her rest from the battlefield!!



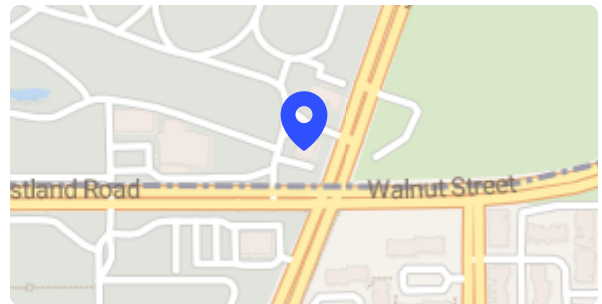
