Well done thy good and faithful servant.



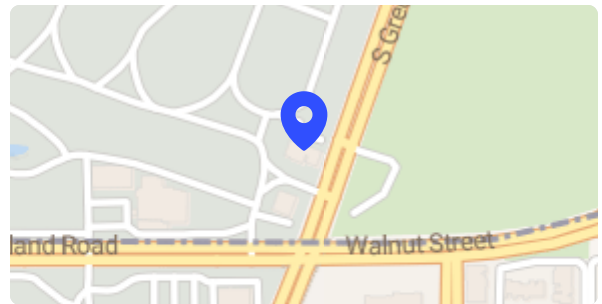

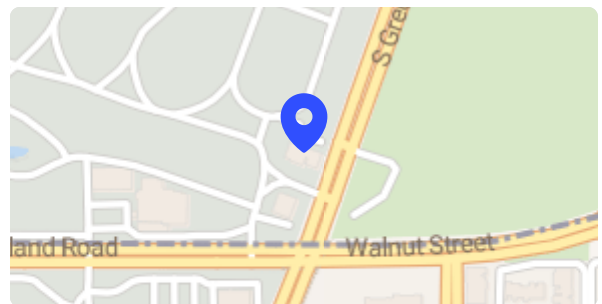

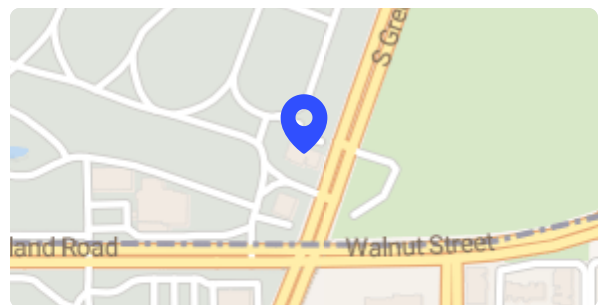
