Eduardo's legacy of faith, love, and devotion to his family will live on in the hearts of all who knew and loved him.

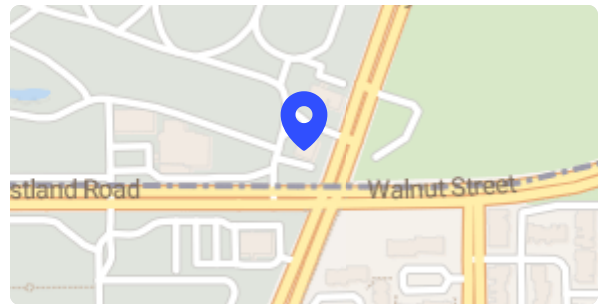

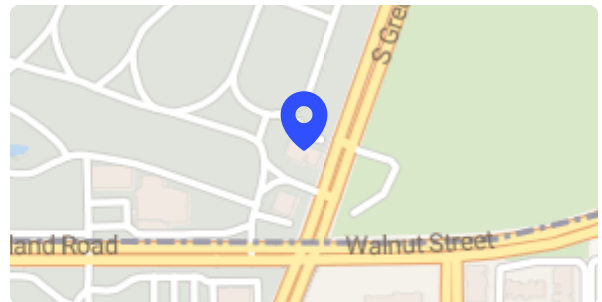

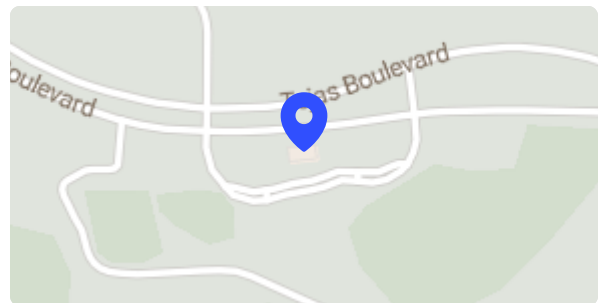
