A near-lifelong resident of East Dallas, he spent his final years living independently in Little Forest Hills, a neighborhood he adored. A graduate of the University of Texas, his career culminated in owning and operating a popular antique furniture store, the English Pine Company, in Dallas and Plano for many years. It also contributed to his passion for soccer, a sport he said he wished he could have played. It often seemed that he never met anyone he did not like, and he conquered obstacles that made his family very proud. He was a proud family man and loved his children and grandchildren very much. Harry was preceded in death by his parents, Harry W. Walker, Jr. and Margaret Walker, and wife, Ellen, who passed in 2015.
