Jeannine Boyce Scott died May 15, 2018, at the age of 78, in Allen, Texas, leaving a legacy of love and kindness. Born Dorothy Jeannine Ramsey in Indianapolis, Indiana, on July 14, 1939, Jeannine moved to Richardson, Texas, in 1966.
