December 3, 1931 - November 16, 2021

Dr. Patricia “Pat” Ruth Kuenstler of Dallas, Texas, was a beloved wife, mother, grandmother, sister, aunt, friend, teacher, co-worker, and child of God. She went home to be with her Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ, on November 16, 2021, at age 89, only 17 days shy of her 90th birthday. Pat was born to Emmett and Bernadean Wyche on December 3, 1931. Pat was a life-long learner and teacher. After graduating from Hot Wells High School in San Antonio, Texas, in 1948, Pat married her high school sweetheart, Frank Kuenstler, on September 4, 1948. When most women stayed home to raise a family, Pat combined her dreams of marriage, motherhood, and education. Pat attended Abilene Christian University, and she graduated from Texas Woman’s University with a Bachelor’s of Sociology in 1965. She continued to pursue her Masters of Art and her Doctorate of Philosophy, emphasizing Sociology, Psychology, and Child Development. Pat continued her education and became a licensed Marriage and Family Therapist. She was still working with clients from the area and around the world until the week she died. Pat and Frank also had five children together: Sheryl, Kimberley, Toy, and Konrad. Pat lost a baby boy at birth on March 22, 1961. Pat was deeply loved by her family. She is survived by her husband, Frank Lloyd Kuenstler, of 73 years; daughter, Dr. Sheryl Ann Hamilton; daughter, Kimberley Dean Ogilvie; daughter, Toy Ruth White; and son, Konrad Kirk Kuenstler. Pat is also survived by sons-in-law, Mark Hamilton, Jack Ogilvie, and Steve White; and
