



## Robert "Bob" D. Hogg

August 26, 1936 - November 24, 2020

Robert D. "Bob" Hogg, 84, passed away November 24, 2020, at Presbyterian Village North, Dallas, TX. Born August 26, 1936, was a graduate of Woodrow Wilson High School and worked for Sun Oil Company for 32 years.

Basic biographical information doesn't begin to describe a man who lived in service to the Lord, his church, his family and his friends.
