She loved sunny days and working in her garden growing all kinds of plants, flowers, and vegetables. She herself was sunshine, her face and voice lit with love and joy whenever she was with family and friends. She was a master at taking lemons and making lemonade; always applying the most positive attitude to resolve or weather a challenging situation.

In her later years, Sherry devoted her life to Christ and found a church home and extended family in Stonebriar Community Church. She trusted in her Savior and found peace, joy, and contentment.
